I also setup a WordPress blog and helped with customize an existing theme. Later, I focused on the video side and created an animated video graphics package for Good Fight as well as logo treatments for the other branches of the organization. In addition, I worked to establish a social networking presence via Facebook, Youtube and Twitter. Generated email blast, product packaging and ads for print. Results yielded an increase in traffic by over 300% and nearly doubled monthly sales.
